A Police Committee meeting of the Village of Arthur, IL, was held on Monday, July 29, 2019. Chairman Michael Hilgenberg called the meeting to order at 5:00 P.M. Roll call was answered by Committee Members Michael Hilgenberg, Justin Ray, Rod Randall, and John McGrath, Citizen Representative. Chief Michael Goodman, was also present. Village Attorney Ken Crossman joined the meeting after roll call.

There were no visitors present, no Public Comment was heard.

There was no unfinished business.

Committee Chairman, Hilgenberg, called on Committee Member, Justin Ray, to present information, under New Business Item 2, Discussion on Unmarked (Stop/Yield) streets within the Village. Ray presented information regarding the large number of "4-way" and "T" intersections, within the Village that have no signage, such as Yield and Stop signs. Chief Goodman presented information regarding accident data from any of the reported intersections and then the committee talked about which intersections might benefit from the addition of signage. The Committee will make the following recommendations to the Village Board of Trustees regarding the placement of signage at the following locations; Yield signs on S. Beech St at intersection with West Boise St., Yield sign on E. Logan St. at intersection with S. Union St., Stop sign on Redbird Lane at intersection with Moses St. and Stop sign on S. Hickory St. at intersection with E. Park St.

Committee Chairman Hilgenberg, called on Attorney Ken Crossman to present information under New Business Item 1, Discussion on Outstanding Unpaid Ordinance Violations. After Crossman presented information, the Committee requested Attorney Crossman address the various Outstanding Ordinance Violations, to include the filing of complaints in Municipal Court if necessary.

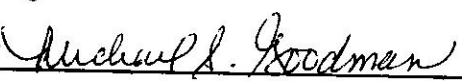
