

June 2, 2025

A regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of Arthur, Illinois was held on Monday, June 2, 2025, in the Village Board Room. Village President Rod Randall called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Roll call was answered by Trustees Matt Bernius, Mike Hilgenberg, Isai Gutierrez, Kurt Hall, Lamar Miller, and Christy Bernius. Also present were Police Chief Elliott Tinnon, Grant Corum, Village Attorney Kenneth Crossman and Arianna Cherry.

Pledge of Allegiance

- President Randall asked Kurt Hall to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Comment

- None

Consent Agenda

- C Bernius made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda including:
 1. Approval of May 19, 2025 Board of Trustees Regular Meeting Minutes.
 2. Approval of April 2025 Leak Adjustment Report.
- M Hilgenberg seconded. All Trustees voted YEA.

Approval of Expenditures

- M. Hilgenberg made a motion to approve expenditures in the amount of \$27,593.56. I Gutierrez seconded. All Trustees voted YEA.

Reports

- Village President - Rod Randall – Municipal aggregation report – Homefield will be lower now that the Ameren rates have been announced.
- Trustee Matt Bernius – Golf carts are once again on the streets. Need to possibly post a notice regarding driving rules when using them in town.
- Trustee Kurt Hall – Inquired about Mike Goodman. Officer Tinnon advised that he is doing well and was in the office for a visit.
- Police Chief Elliott Tinnon – Stated that there was nothing really outstanding on the monthly report. He noted that with better weather comes higher call volume which is reflected in the report.
- Trustee Lamar Miller – Inquired about lockout calls and whether the police support those for auto and homes. Police Chief Tinnon stated that the police department does support both and stated distance covered and fees for such calls.
- Public Works – Grant Corum – Stated that there were 25 dead water meters this month which was higher than usual. He also stated that there was a large tree removal at 216 West Illinois which was an emergency situation due to the size and the damage to the tree. It was removed by Tuesday. Lastly, he stated that there were 2 water line leaks due to tree roots within the last 2 weeks.


General Discussion
