

June 1, 2026

A regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of Arthur, Illinois was held on Monday, June 1, 2026, in the Village Board Room. Village President Rod Randall called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Roll call was answered by Trustees Jim Fleming, Isai Gutierrez, Kurt Hall and Lamar Miller. Also present were Public Works Grant Corum, Village Attorney Kenneth Crossman and Ariana Cherry.

Pledge of Allegiance

- President Randall asked Lamar Miller to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Comment

- None.

Consent Agenda

- I Gutierrez made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda including:
 - Approval of May 18, 2026 Board of Trustee Regular Meeting Minutes.
 - Approval of May 18, 2026 Executive Session Minutes.
- L Miller seconded. All Trustees voted YEA.

Approval of Expenditures

- J Fleming reviewed the monthly expenditures. Jim made a note of two larger payments, a loan payment and a street sweeper payment. J Fleming made a motion to approve expenditures in the amount of \$105,850.51. K Hall seconded. All Trustees voted YEA.

Reports

- Trustee – K Hall – Noted in the activity log for the Public Works that it appears that street painting would be coming up soon. He wondered if anything had been looked at as far as the handicapped spots downtown before any painting would be completed. Kurt noted that Illinois Street, all four corners, might be beneficial for more than one reason.
- Police – R Randall – Noted the police report was available for review.
- Public Works – Grant Corum
 - Reviewed the Public Works Activity Log and noted that they are still locating for Fidium.
 - Cross Connection Survey and Consumer Confidence Report – those two things will be going out. They will be sent out separately.
 - Noted that he met with the school district. There will be a fire hydrant installed in front of the school. There will be fencing going up around the construction area likely later this week with demolition to begin June 8.
 - Computer security enhancements are being finished up for the Public Works Department.
 - Hydrant flushing will be dependent on how much the school construction will be using the hydrant as well.

 - J Fleming made a motion to enter an Executive Session. L Miller seconded. All Trustees voted YEA.
 - K Hall made a motion to return to regular session. L Miller seconded. All Trustees voted YEA.
 - No action was taken.

General Discussion

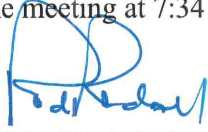
- Rod Randall – Fly Your Flag for Freedom – Presented the flagpole and sign options and the order form.
