## April 14, 2016

A Police Committee meeting of the Village of Arthur, IL, was held on Thursday, April 14, 2016. Chairman Matt Bernius called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Roll call was answered by Committee Members Matt Bernius and James Aikman. Committee Member Dave Tiffan was absent. Chief Michael Goodman and Village Trustee Terry Clark were also present, as well as Judson Wienke, visitor.

Committee Chairman, Matt Bernius, invited Chief Goodman to present information under New Business Items, Discussion on hiring new police officer. Chief Goodman provided information regarding the hiring process, including information that 14 applications had been received, from persons interested in the open position of police officer with the Arthur Police Department. Chief Goodman had narrowed down the applications and had interviewed four applicants, for the position. Chief Goodman presented information to the Committee recommending a candidate for consideration. The candidate, Judson Wienke, was recommended to be hired, to fill the position with the Police Department, as a full-time Police Officer. Judson Wienke was present, to meet Committee Members, and to answer any questions that they might have. The recommendation included information requesting that Wienke be presented to the Village Board of Trustees, at their next regularly scheduled meeting on Monday, April 18, 2016, and that a motion to hire Wienke be made at that time, at a starting salary of \$15.70 per hour.

Committee Chairman, Matt Bernius, invited Chief Goodman to present information and to lead a discussion with Committee Members, regarding the upcoming 2016-2017 Police Department Budget. Chief Goodman presented information to committee members regarding the Police Budget and advised that a document outlining the proposed changes to the Police Budget would be available to the Village Board, at their Work Session meeting, regarding the Village's Annual Budget.

Matt Bernius made a motion to adjourn; James Aikman seconded. Committee Chair, Matt Bernius adjourned the meeting at 9:33 a.m.
